The Timberwolves Foundation is a group of dedicated parents and staff who have come together to fundraise for MVHS. Our goal is to raise money that will allow us to enhance the quality of education at Mission Vista High School.

The Timberwolves Foundation is pleased to offer a senior scholarship each year. Interested students will need to fill out the respective applications and submit them by the application deadline April 30, 2021.

Mission Vista High School is a school of choice for students in the Vista Unified School District as well as surrounding communities. The 4x4 block schedule and four focus areas of Arts, Communication, Science and Technology make this school a unique option for students in North San Diego County.

The Timberwolves Foundation Scholarship:

The Mission Vista High School Timberwolves Foundation is offering two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000. This is a one-time award and cannot be renewed. Scholarships will be presented at the annual Senior Awards Night. The Timberwolves Foundation will pay scholarship funds directly to the recipient's post-secondary school. The Timberwolves Foundation Scholarship is awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, religion, gender or sexual orientation. The Timberwolves Foundation Scholarship will be administered by the MVHS Timberwolves Foundation.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher
- ✓ Applicants must have twelve hours of specific community service
- ✓ Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a college, university, or trade school program for the upcoming academic year.
- ✓ Applicants must be a US citizen or permanent resident alien.

Application Process:

To apply, students must submit the following on or before April 30, 2021.

- ✓ Completed scholarship application form
- ✓ A signed letter demonstrating a minimum twelve hours of community service toward an event while enrolled as a student at MVHS. The letter must be verifiable from the organization's event leader describing:
 - ✓ The event
 - ✓ Your participation
 - ✓ Number of hours worked toward the cause
 - ✓ Example events could be: tutoring kids for 12 hours or feeding the homeless for 12 hours or Eagle Scout project for 12 hours.
- ✓ One teacher reference letter
- ✓ Official transcript
- ✓ Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies
- ✓ Applicant to write a short essay and briefly include a personal statement that offers information about academic, athletic, extracurricular and/or leadership roles and responsibilities that make you a suitable candidate for a scholarship with the Timberwolves Foundation name.

Scholarship Awards:

- ✓ Award notification will be given at the annual senior Awards Night
- ✓ For fund disbursement, an applicant must provide their student ID, the correct mailing address of their institution and the department where their scholarship check is to be received.
